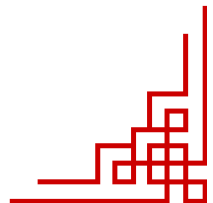
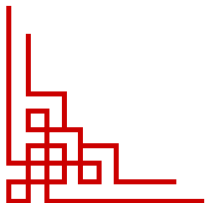
1. Look at the Golden Dragon menu and the House of Noodles menu.

3. Use the ingredient you get (two words) as one of the passwords for the case notes question.

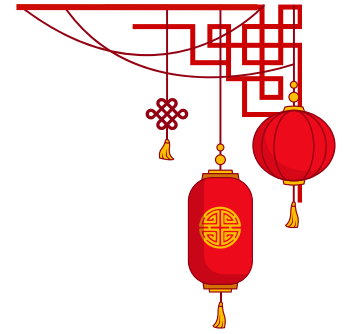
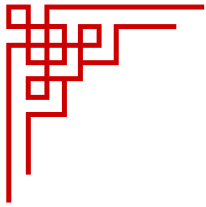




MAHJONG AND CHOPSTICKS

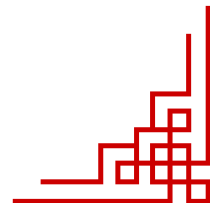
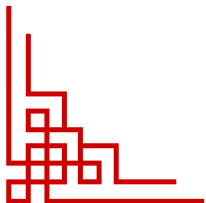
1. You need to use the 2 chopsticks with the eight Mahjong pieces around some letters.
2. Use the paper that labels all of the Mahjong pieces to identify what the eight Mahjong pieces are called.
3. One of the photocopy notes mentions those pieces and puts them into groups.
4. Lay the chopsticks over the Mahjong pieces and make note of what letter the chopsticks intersect on.
5. The message you get will start with “check...”
6. Use what you get(one word) as one of the passwords for the case notes question.

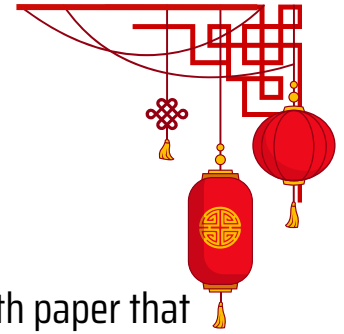
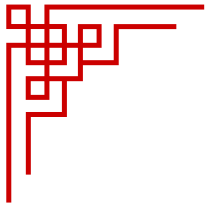




FOUR ROWS MAHJONG

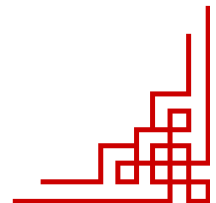
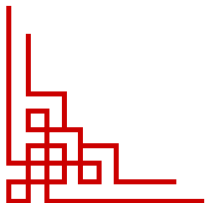
1. Look at the names of the Mahjong pieces and make note that the values are 1 through 9.
2. Treat the four rows of tiles as numbers. If two tiles are touching, that is a two-digit number.
3. Now translate the numbers to letters using 1 = A, 2= B, 3= C, etc.
4. The message you get will start with "Dining area..."
5. Use what you get(one word) as one of the passwords for the case notes question.

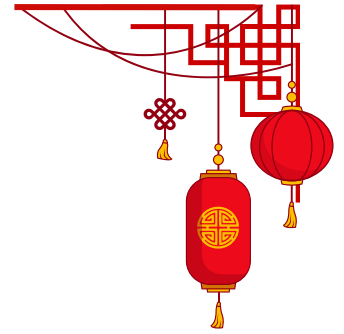
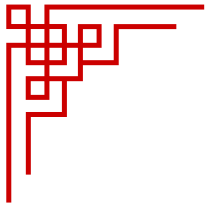




JOURNEY BEGINS HERE

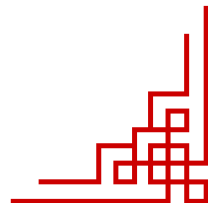
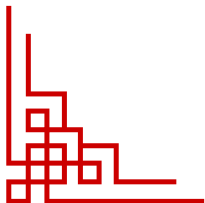
1. Use the note from the photocopy that mentions “Journey” with paper that has a grid of letters and the phrase “Journey Begins Here.”
2. The Chinese symbols from the photocopies are for the four cardinal directions. If you look at the Mahjong tiles, you will be able to tell what they are.
3. Use the directions to move letter by letter.
4. Once you are done, read the letters you did NOT pass over. Read them from left to right, starting at the top.
5. The message you get will start with “I hope you...”
6. Use what you get(one word) as one of the passwords for the case notes question.

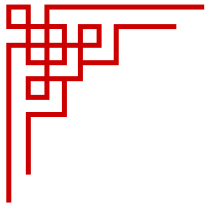




PAPER HAND FANS

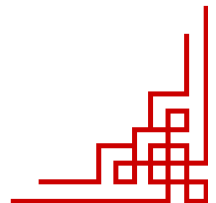
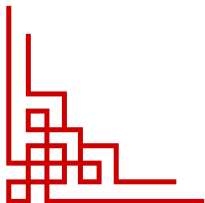
1. There is a clue on how to translate the fans into letters among the photocopies of the notes.
2. The fans at the top of the paper are the key. There are 26 fans, just like the number of letters in the alphabet.
3. For the first group of four fans that make a circle, the top fan is A, the left fan is B, the right fan is C, and the bottom fan is D. Use this pattern to get the rest of the fans, and then translate the fans below.
4. The message you get will start with “If you feel...”
5. Use what you get(one word) as one of the passwords for the case notes question.

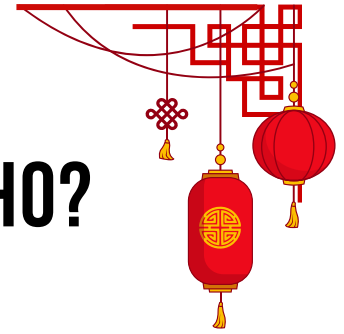
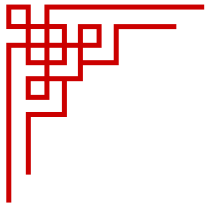




SAFE/KOI FISH

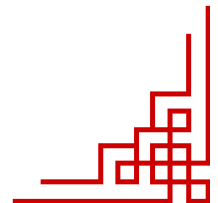
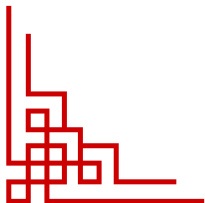

4. This will get you the numbers you need.

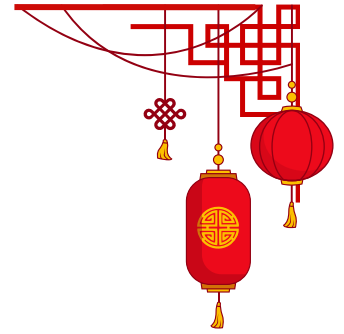
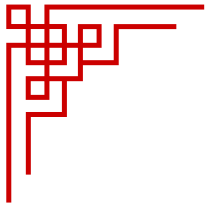




CHINESE ZODIAC - WHO IS WHO?

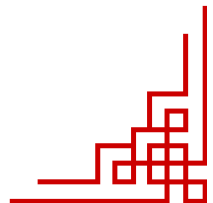
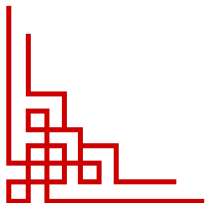
1. You need to have unlocked the safe before you can do this.

3. If you are having trouble, here are two of them: Lee Táng is the Pig and Gin Huáng is the Rabbit

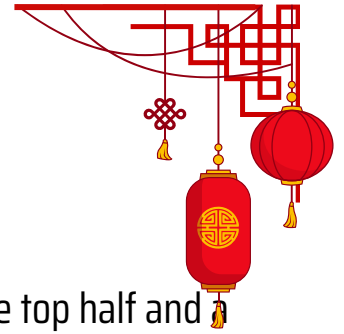
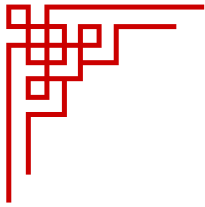




GRANNY YU

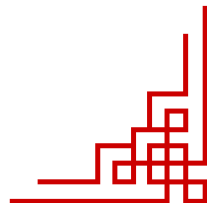
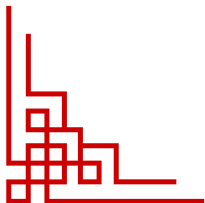
1. You need to have solved all of the puzzles mentioned above before you can do this.

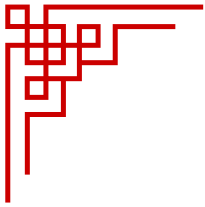




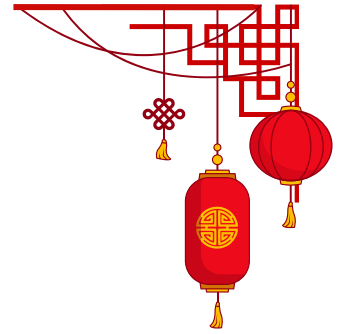
THREE COINS

1. Use the three coins with the paper that has a letter grid on the top half and list of repeating letters in groups of three on the bottom half.
2. Place the coins on the grid of letters so that you can see the letters mentioned on the list below the grid.
3. Once all three coins are placed, there should be a letter between them. That is the letter you need.
4. The first letter you get is the letter U.
5. Use what you get (two words) as one of the passwords for the question on the note from the Rat.

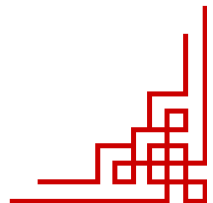
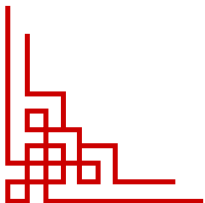


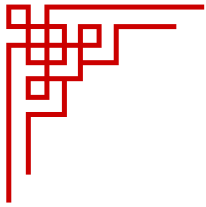


DRAGONS



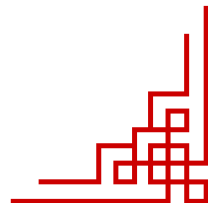
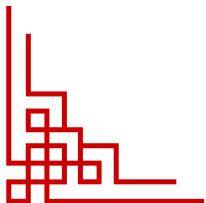
1. Use the menu from the Golden Dragon with what is in the dragon's claws.

5. Use what you get(one word) as one of the passwords for the question on the note from the Rat.

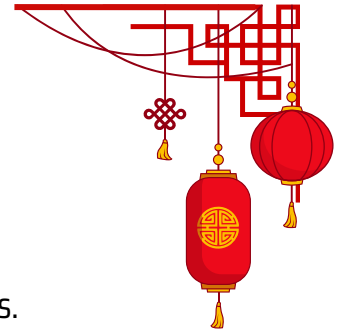
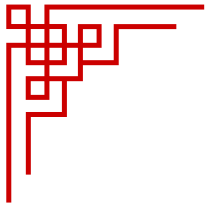




FEELING LUCKY?

The fortune message you find on your car eliminates a suspect. The fortune was written by the rat, and the dragon is the one who is dead. What sign do they have in common?

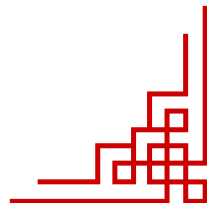
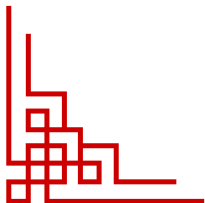
The fortune message you find under a melon eliminates two of the suspects.

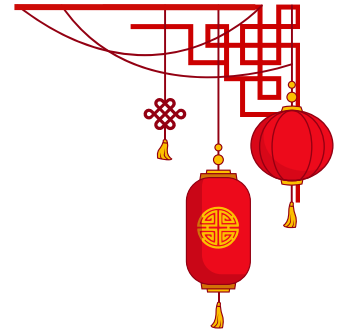
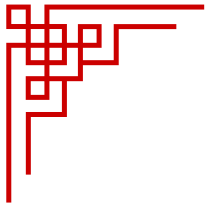
The fortune message you find under a chair eliminates one of the suspects.
