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PART ONE - PUZZLE 1

- 1. You will use "The Wunder Works Zoo" sign with this puzzle.
- 2. Some of the letters in the sign have animals on them.
- 3. Use the letters the animals are on to decode the animal message.
- 4. Example: The zebra is on N, so make all of the zebras in Puzzle 1 the letter N.
- 5. The giraffe is on 0, so make all of the giraffes in Puzzle 1 the letter 0. Follow this pattern for the other animals.









PART ONE - PUZZLE 2

- 1. Use the photo of the Menu with this puzzle.
- 2. The first number in each pair stands for the order number.
- 3. The second number in each pair stands for the letter within that order.
- 4. So (5,13) would mean to go to order number 5, and take the 13th letter, which in this case would be the letter W.









PART ONE - PUZZLE 3

- 1. Work backwards from the blank to find where the first arrow is.
- 2. Now use the arrows with the photo of the red graffiti letters.
- 3. Start on the letter that matches the same spot as the first arrow you found. Then move as the arrows direct you.
- 4. The message will start with, "Join..."









PART ONE - FINAL

- 1. Only do this if you have solved puzzles 1, 2, and 3 from this section.
- 2. Use the arrows under innocent for the three innocent suspects, then use the arrows under guilty for the person who is guilty.
- 3. If you do not get the correct answer, you most likely eliminated the wrong suspect.










PART TWO - PUZZLE 1

- 1. You can not see all of the fruits in the photo due to the angle, but it is possible to figure out how many there are.
- 2. The fruits are stacked up like pyramids. Here is an above view of what the coconuts would look like using circles. The red circle is the top coconut, and the blue ones are the ones under it.



- 3. As you can see, there are five total coconuts. One on top and four on the bottom.
- 4. Use this to help you figure out the amount of the other fruits.
- 5. Once you have the answers and you have done the math, you will get a two-digit number. Remember it is the last number that matters.









PART TWO - PUZZLE 2

- 1. Use the list of North American Wildlife animals with this puzzle.
- 2. Get all of the animals placed in the correct enclosures.
- 3. Below are the twelve enclosures, with three of the animals placed correctly. The first one also has the letter you will get if you follow the instructions correctly.

9	10	11	12 Gray Wolf










PART TWO - PUZZLE 3
