Photos Of Rings Of Letters

- 1. On the note from The Helper, you will notice that he mentions three different shapes and a snowflake.
- 2. Take a close look at the three Polaroid photos with the rings of letters surrounding a triangle, circle, and star.
- 3. Using the notes from The Helper, lay the snowflake across the Polaroids to get the correct letters that you need to get the hidden message.
- 4. Note that on each ring of letters there is an underlined letter, this is the start point for each photo.
- 5. If you lay the snowflake across the photo with the top of the snowflake (where the hole is) pointing north it will cover six of the letters. Use the letters that remain, starting with the underlined letter.
- 6. You should get the letters "I T I S N O"
- 7. The message you get will help you eliminate a suspect

Victor's Dressing Room Door

- 1. On Victor's dressing room door, it reads "Which list..." What item in the box could this be referring to?
- 2. Notice the "Naughty and Nice List" has all the names of the cast and crew members and the door also lists different groupings of cast and crew members.
- 3. There is a hint on the door that mentions the word <u>trace</u>. How could you use this hint with the "Naughty and Nice List"?
- 4. Trace the names on the "Naughty and Nice List" that you find on the door. Think of it as connecting the dots.
- 5. You will be creating four numbers when you trace the names.
- 6. This will unlock Victor's dressing room door.

Message On The Mirror In Victor's Dressing Room

(Need to have Victor's dressing room door unlocked)

- 1. The symbols drawn on the mirror in Victor's dressing room should remind you of something else that relates to Christmas.
- 2. Match the symbols on the mirror to the 12 days of Christmas.
- 3. You should have two simple math problems that will help you complete the message.
- 4. The first math problem you get should be 12, divided by 4, then minus 2.
- 5. The second math problem you get should be 1, plus 3 plus 7, then minus 8.
- 6. This message will help you eliminate a person if you look carefully through the "A Christmas Carol" cast list.

Painted Letters

- 1. You found some letters painted in various colors. Where else have you seen all of those colors?
- 2. On the note left from The Helper, notice the row of different colors across the bottom.
- 3. Using the order of the colored lines from The Helper's note, fill in the painted letters to get a message. (Black = space)
- 4. The message should start with "The murderer..."
- 5. This message will help you eliminate a suspect after you've completed the secret Santa puzzle.

Secret Santa

(Need to have Victor's dressing room door unlocked)

- 1. Use Chloe Davis' interview with the gift tag from Victor's room.
- 2. Focus on filling in the Secret Santa list using the ones that you know for sure based on the interview with Chloe and the gift tag found in Victor's dressing room. Once you have done that, filling in the rest should be a little bit easier.

Unlocking Abigail Wilson Information

(Need to have Victor's dressing room door unlocked first.)

- 1. You will need to finish the Secret Santa puzzle to get what you need to unlock Abigail's information.
- 2. Use Chloe Davis' interview, with the gift tag from Victor's room, to fill in the names of who is who's Secret Santa.
- 3. Focus on filling in the Secret Santa list using the ones that you know for sure based on the interview with Chloe and the gift tag found in Victor's dressing room. Once you have done that filling in the rest should be a little bit easier

Storage Case/Christmas Shelves

(Need to unlock Abigail Wilson information first)

- 1. Abigail mentions that to get the case open will take a little bit of math.
- 2. She also gives you the order needed for the numbers.
- 3. To get the numbers look at the Christmas decorations on the shelves. The numbers at the end of each row and at the top of each column represent the total value of each row and column.
- 4. If you are having trouble with the puzzle, try focusing on the bottom row and second column.

Car And Car Key

- 1. The keys you find in the storage case have a message on them along with several letters.
- 2. How many letters come between each set of letters?
- 3. The numbers you get here will help you unlock the car.
- 4. Once the car is unlocked you should find something that will help you eliminate a suspect.
- 5. Make sure you remember who the key belongs to in order to know which suspect to eliminate.

Christmas Tree Lights And Card

(Need to have the storage case unlocked)

- 1. You have two things that relate to a Christmas tree. Pair them up and see what you get.
- 2. Use the Christmas card with the blinking lights video.
- 3. The letters you get from this will spell out a message that will help you eliminate a suspect after you have gotten the storage case opened.
- 4. The message should start with. "Not the..."

Joanna's Playlist/Song List from Abigail And Notes From Soundbooth

(Need to have Abigail's information unlocked)

- 1. In the soundbooth, you found a few different things, one of which was "Joanna's playlist." It would not play properly and kept skipping at certain times. Pair this with the information that Abigail gives you.
- 2. Pay special attention to the note from The Helper that was found in the sound booth. It is a hint on how to work this puzzle.
- 3. "I can't get the lines and words ..."
- 4. Use the minute marker as the number of the song in the list Abigail gives you and the second marker as the word in the song title.
- 5. The message should start with "Hark is..."

Brick Wall and Presents

(Need to have Abigail's information unlocked)

- 1. You will need to have solved the first part of this puzzle which is Joanna's playlist.
- 2. In the soundbooth, you found a wall that was crumbling and had words written on the bricks
- 3. Pair this with the message he leaves about the presents and you will notice that the numbers in each row and column for the bricks and presents match.
- 4. Using the words you got from the song, which should be three words, match them up to the bricks and then match them up to the presents.
- 5. This should help you eliminate a suspect.

Where Is The Helper

You will need to have eliminated all but one suspect to do this puzzle.

Final

Eliminate all suspects and get the motive from the "Where is the Helper?" unlock.
