He has seen progress, but you might find getting his testimony to be difficult. Avoid mentioning anything about the weather or trees. He claims they are suspicious. Animals seem to have a calming effect on him.

Joseph is often called "the professor" as he is obsessed with mathematical equations. However, Joseph seems to have created his own way of doing math. The equations he writes out do not follow conventional mathematical operations. Do not tell him he is doing it wrong. When Joseph first arrived here, a former nurse made that mistake, and in a fit of rage, Joseph nearly strangled her to death. While his math operations seem nonsensical, Joseph is always right regarding numbers. He can enter a room and tell you within five seconds the number of tiles on the floor.

Susan had an accident the day of the fire, so she she was in the medical care room for some time until she was evacuated due to the fire. Susan was admitted to Saturn Hills when she was found at the scene of the infamous nineteen ninety nine Christmas slayings. She was the only one found alive, and with her refusal to talk, it has never been determined if she was a victim or perpetrator. Susan is non verbal, but we have been unable to determine exactly why she chooses not to talk. While she may not be of much help, she is one of the few patients to have been housed in Ward C before it burned. She loves to play cards.

Transcript from Tape:
