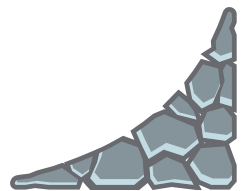
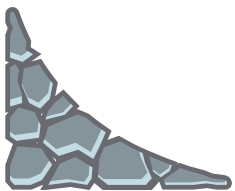


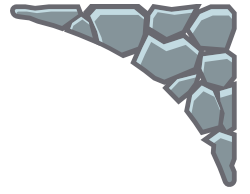
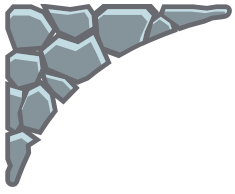
# CASE 1 - PUZZLE 2

“The one with the two-headed eagle didn’t take it.”

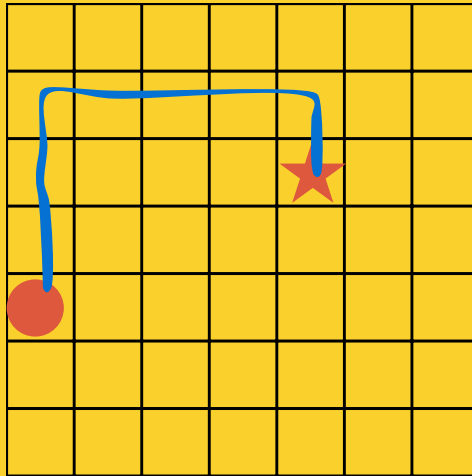
Beside each suspect’s name is their sheild crest. One of those crests in a two-headed eagle.

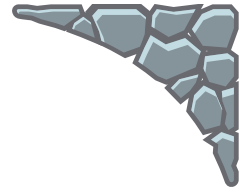
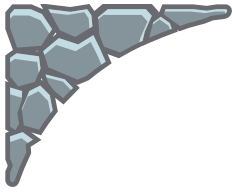

Dragon = M

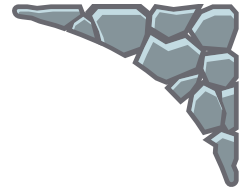
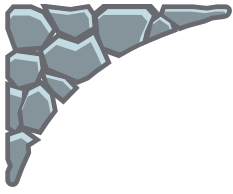
