# **MURDER AT THE MOVIES - EPISODE 2** Q HINT FILES \*One Puzzle Per Page

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### **FLASH DRIVE**

- 1. Pay close attention to the wording at the beginning of the video. There is a clue to help you identify which document is needed with the flash drive.
- 2. Who has been hiding?
- 3. In the groupings of numbers, the first number refers to one part of the associated document while the second number refers to a different part of the associated document.
- 4. Using the flyer of David Winchester, use the groupings of numbers to identify specific letters on the flyer.
- 5. The first number refers to the line on the flyer. The second number refers to the letter on that line.



# **GAS TANKS**

- 1. You are asked to restore atmospheric balance on the ship. First, you need to search through the documents to identify what numbers represent balance.
- 2. Once you have identified the numbers that represent balance, calculate the difference between the current pressure from the gas tanks and the numbers that represent balance.
- 3. Once you have the three numbers to restore balance, see if those three numbers correspond to anything else.
- 4. Take a look at the Space Counsel information.
- 5. Once you have information from the Space Counsel, see what that piece of information corresponds to on another document.



# **DEEP SPACE ENCOUNTER BORDER**

- 1. Does the border look like anything inside the USS Pandora information?
- 2. Use the alphabet key to solve the morse code encryption around the Deep Space Encounter poster.



# DEEP SPACE ENCOUNTER POSTER BACK

- 1. The shape is missing some of its numbers. See if you can find something on another document that connects to this.
- 2. Look inside the USS Pandora information.
- 3. Rewrite and combine the numbers and symbols from both identical shapes.
- 4. Focus on the equal signs first.
- 5. Once you know the equal values, solve for the question marks?
- 6. Add up all the numbers in the row that has an equal sign and see what total you get. Add up all the numbers in the column that has an equal sign and see what total you get. These two totals should be the same.
- 7. Now, figure out what numbers could replace the questions marks to make all columns and rows equal the same values as the two with equal signs.
- 8. Once you have values for the three questions marks, see if those three numbers correspond to anything else.
- 9. Take a look at the Space Counsel information.
- 10. Once you have information from the Space Counsel, see what that piece of information corresponds to on another document.



# YEAR 3000 CALENDAR

- 1. Take a look at the USS Pandora information that starts with "There are..."
- 2. Notice how the groupings of numbers are written like dates.
- 3. When the message refers to many different stars, what could that mean?
- 4. Remember, you might need to use items or information from Episode 1 with this.
- 5. Once you identify what's needed from Episode 1, focus on the word "Under" on how to solve the puzzle.
- 6. You will need the gold star from Episode 1. Put it over the dates listed with the arrow pointing down and see what letter it points down representing being "under" the star.



# **GRID OF LETTERS**

- 1. Figure out how many squares are in the grid. See anything else that mentions that number?
- 2. Look at the USS Pandora information starting with "Bk 1, 3..."
- 3. What could correspond Bk, O, B, Br, and Y?
- 4. Use the colored beads and place into the appropriate squares of the grid.
- 5. Once you have all beads placed on the grid, see what image the beads form. Then, see if any other piece of information from the USS Pandora can help reveal a message.



# **SOLUTION**

- 1. You need to identify the 7 people connected to the information revealed from the envelope.
- 2. One name will come from the Flash Drive puzzle.
- 3. One name will come from the Gas Tanks puzzle.
- 4. Two names will come from the Deep Space Encounter poster morse code.
- 5. One name will come from the puzzle on the back of the Deep Space Encounter poster.
- 6. Two names will come from the Year 3000 Calendar puzzle.
