

- 4. This will eliminate that person as a suspect.









CASE 1 - PUZZLE 2

- 4. Draw the lines out on a piece of paper. If you aren't getting letters, you might have the wands on the white paper upside down.













- 1. Use the four handkerchiefs with the piece of paper with the colored letters.








CASE 2 - PUZZLE 1








CASE 2 - PUZZLE 3
