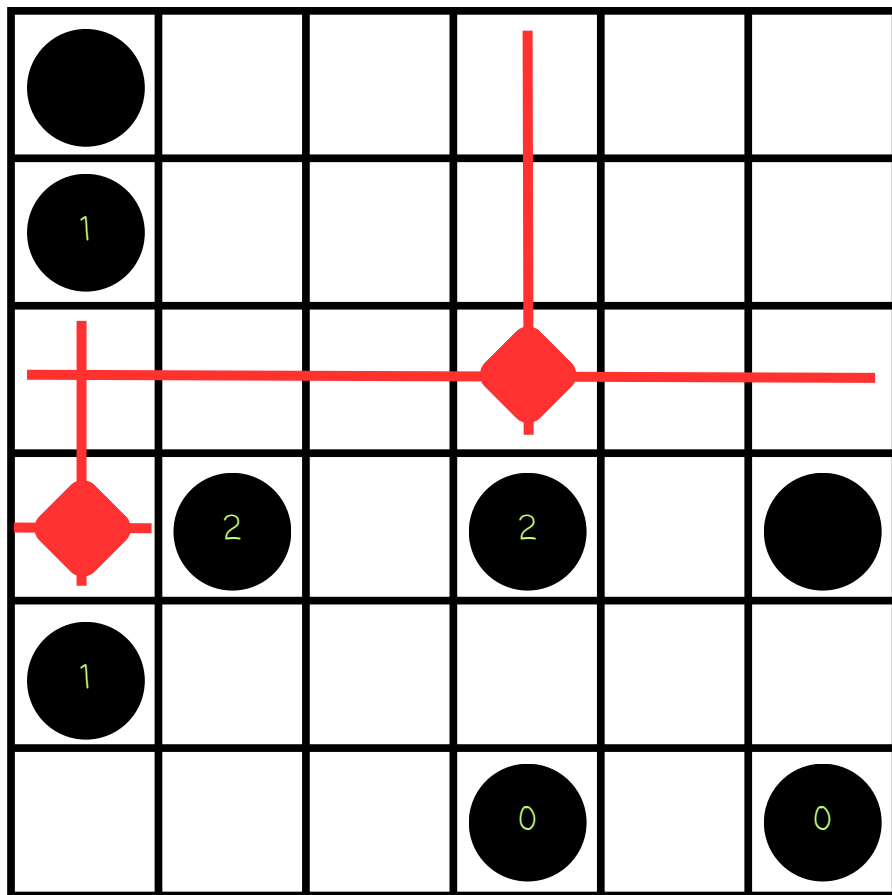
# MARY CLARKE/CAROL TEXT MESSAGE

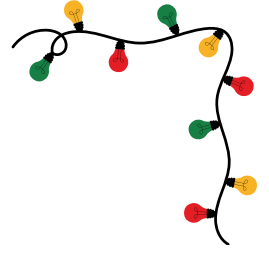
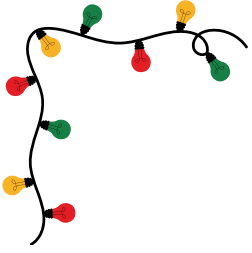
1. The text message and the Christmas Carol, Deck the Halls, go together.

5. The message you get will start with, “the party...”
6. Once you unlock Mary’s information, she will give you some information that will let you eliminate a suspect.



# KEVIN/SECURITY SENSORS

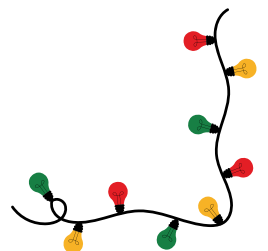
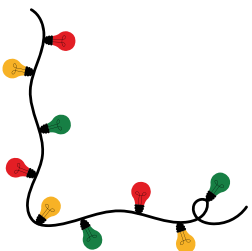
1. You need to use all seven sensors, and they need to be placed so that they fulfill the requirements with the numbers on the circles.

3. Once you unlock Kevin's information, he will give you some information that will enable you to eliminate a suspect.

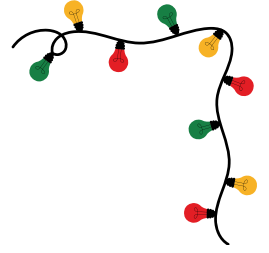
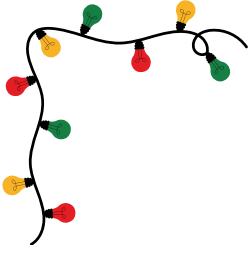




# GRANDPA/CHRISTMAS CARD

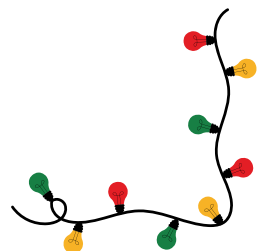
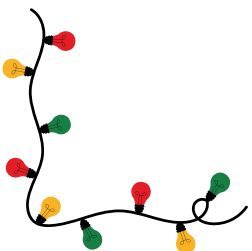
1. There are letters hidden in the Christmas card.

3. Once you unlock Grandpa's information, he will give you some information that will enable you to eliminate a suspect.

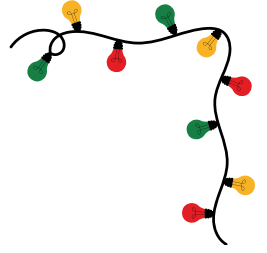
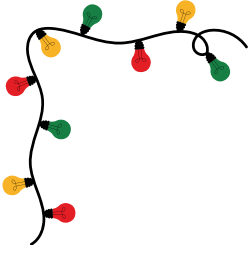




# CINDY/RECIPE

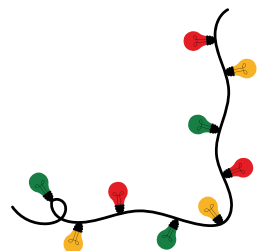
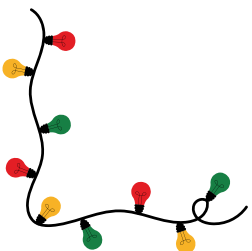
1. You need to read Cindy's and Granny's interviews, as well as the Christmas Cookies recipe in order to do this puzzle.
2. Compare the list of ingredients from the recipe with the ingredients Granny mentions. This will enable you to fill in the missing words.
3. Pay attention to the things Granny points out.
4. Like the fact that there is MORE brown sugar than white sugar.
5. The last missing thing(number 7) can be figured out by process of elimination. It is the only ingredient from the list you have not mixed in yet.
6. Once you unlock Cindy's information, she will give you some information that will enable you to eliminate a suspect.

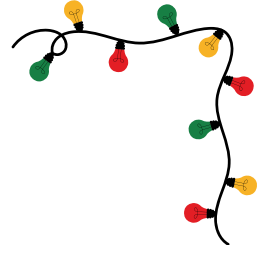
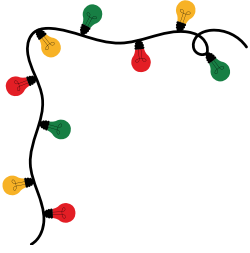




# RALPHIE/MANTLE

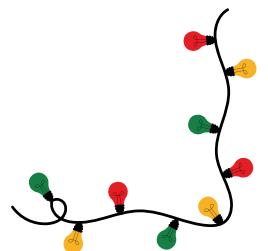
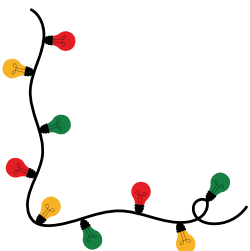
1. Use the Mantle with Ralphie's explanation on the back of Whisker's card.

4. The message you get will be used with the message you get from the present puzzle.

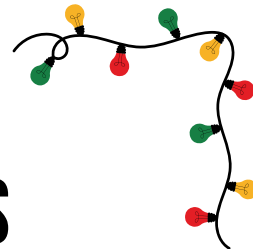
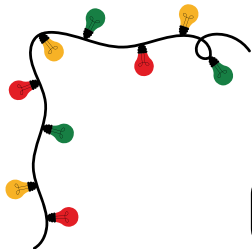


# PRESENTS

1. First, find the correct path to get all 15 presents and write down the letters you get. They will not make a message at first, and will just look like random letters.
2. Look below to see four of the presents that are part of the path.
3. Second, once you have the path, identify the tenth present.
4. Then use the number on the matched present at the bottom of the sheet.
5. Finally, shift the letters you wrote down forward in the alphabet by the same amount as the number on the present.
6. EXAMPLE: If the tenth present were the present with a 3 on it, you would move forward in the alphabet 3 places. So an A would change to a D. (This is just an example and is not the correct amount.)
7. The message you get will be two words.
8. You will use this with the message you get from the word search to learn more about where the lights are.

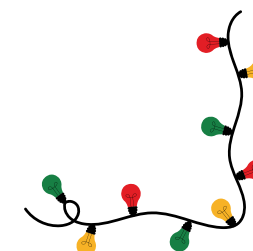
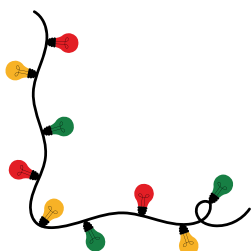

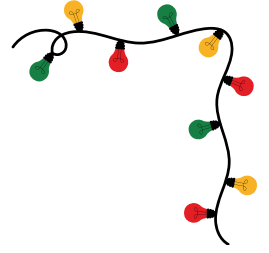
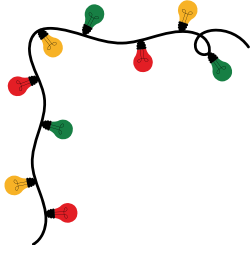




# COMBINE PUZZLES - PRESENTS AND WORD SEARCH

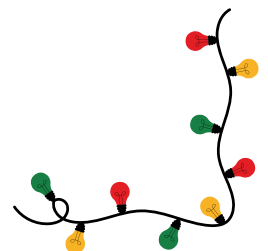
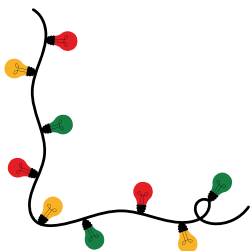
1. You need to have solved the present puzzle and the word search to be able to do this.
2. Follow the instructions you are given in the hidden message from the word search on the message from the present puzzle to pull the correct letters and make an 8-letter word.

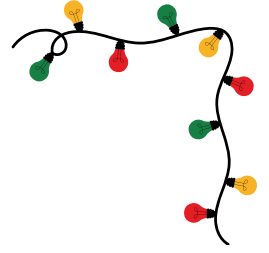
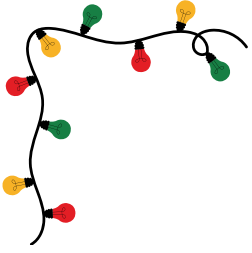




# HOW MANY...?

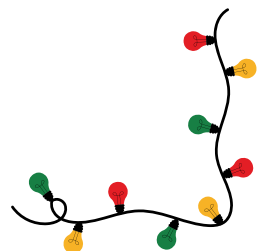
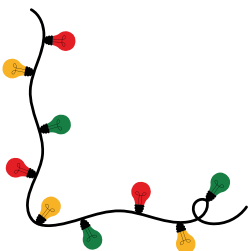
1. Count how many snowmen, sleighs, snowflakes, and bits of holly there are on the sheet.

# GRID OF CHRISTMAS THINGS

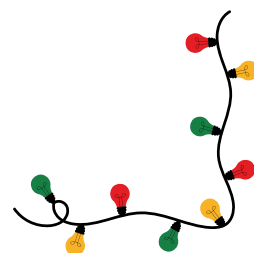
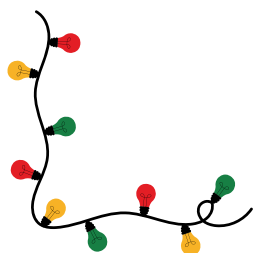
1. The Christmas icons in the grid add up to equal the numbers at the top and right of the grid.

4. The bells are worth 18.

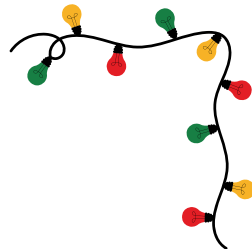
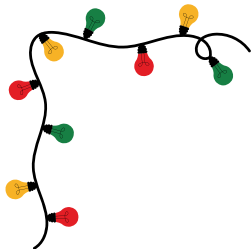




# COMBINATION PUZZLES - HOW MANY AND GRID
