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ROUND 1 RULES

Road Trip

Announcer:

“Here it is, television's most popular game show. It's the Ultimate Game Show. And boy do we have a show for you on this 1000th episode special. Now, to explain today's games, here is your host...ROB ROGERS!”

Rob:



“It's time to play Road Trip! In Road Trip, players must use all twelve of their road pieces to build a path from the start to the finish line, trying to visit all the landmarks they can. Pieces must be placed so that the letter icon is in the top left corner. But there is a catch. Once contestants place their pieces and hit the drive button, some of the road pieces will rotate. The contestants don't know which ones will change, so there is a bit of luck in the game. All right, start your engines!”

Money Mountain

“Here on the stage, we have some lovely prizes, all of which you have an opportunity to take home. However, the only thing stopping you is the summit of Money Mountain. The contestants will first determine the price of each item using these price tags. They will then choose five of the items to take up money mountain. If they have priced them correctly, they will reach the summit. If you go over, you lose it all.”

Guess that Phrase

“Before you are two phrases. Both are related to the same topic. The white squares represent the letters that are missing. As the contestants guess the letters, we will add them to the puzzle. However, if you attempt to guess the phrase and are wrong, you are out! So put on your thinking caps and get to guessing!”





ROUND 2 RULES

Code Word

Announcer:

“Welcome back to the show. Here, in round two, we have more challenges for our lucky contestants. Do you think they have what it takes to win big? Without further ado, here to explain the games is your host, ROB ROGERS!”

Rob:



“Code Word is played over three rounds where contestants are given clues to guess a word or name. Every time you make an incorrect guess, you are given a new clue. Guess correctly and progress to the next round. Do it before everyone else and win big!”

Focus

“Each contestant is given 16 double-sided picture squares that, once assembled correctly, will give them two picture puzzles. From there, they must determine what phrase or message the picture is trying to convey. Remember contestants, don't lose focus!”

Take a Chance

“The game starts for contestant one with the \$200 spot lit up, and then the light will move clockwise around the board rapidly. You can press the button to stop it at any time. After that, you can choose to go again, but look out for the fortune foodies. They will gobble up all of your money, and once that happens, you are out. You can stop at any time or push your luck and win big at Take a Chance!”
