# SEAN/ALLITERATION

1. The note Sean finds is the green note that mentions “Alliteration.”
2. Also, in case you have forgotten, alliteration is the occurrence of the same letter at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words.
3. The numbers on the note are a reference to the episode guide. Use the season and episode numbers.
4. The clue about alliteration is so you will notice that the episode titles use alliteration.
5. Example: if you have the number 1.9 you will go to season 1, episode 9, which is The Abby Adventure. The letter used in the alliteration part of the title is A. So you would translate 1.9 to A. Do the same for the other numbers you get on the note.

# MAGAZINE COVER: NATALIE

4. The letters left will make a message, that starts with “I know...”
