- 1. Use the lunch menu with this puzzle.
- 2. The words FIRST and LETTER are made to stand out because they are clues.
- 3. Fri-D stands for Friday Desserts. This give you the letter I since it is the first letter in ice cream.
- 4. Fri-E2 stands for Friday second Entree. This gives you the letter T.







CASE 1 - PUZZLE 2

- 1. First, read all of the faces that are looking to the right.
- 2. After that, follow the instructions you get from the right-facing heads to read the remaining letters correctly.







CASE 1 - PUZZLE 3

- 1. You need to pick the right tools and supplies in the correct order to get a two-word message.
- 2. Read all of the instructions before you try to sort them.
- 3. Hint: Gloves are first.

CASE 2 - PUZZLE 1

- 1. First, figure out the order of the student's classes.
- 2. Once that is done, write out the class symbols and the letters that are under them in the correct order to get a message.
- 3. Hint: History is first, and Art is second.







CASE 2 - PUZZLE 2

- 1. This is a coded message you have to decipher.
- 2. The + and the x tell you which grid to look at, and the number tells you what letter in that grid to use.
- 3. Example: the first word is "FOR" x4 = F, x8 = 0, and +6 = R







CASE 2 - PUZZLE 3

- 1. Complete the word search.
- 2. Then mark out and letters you are told the remove that you haven't already marked through when finding the words.
- 3. Read the remaning letters
