Matching Up Suspects With Their Homes

1. Marjorie Garcia drew a diagram of the homes in the area of Fairmont Estates (Where Each Suspect Lives)
2. Use her descriptions of each suspect (Marj's Thoughts From Behind The Wall) to connect each symbol on the home diagram to each suspect.

Accessing The Root Cellar

1. In her “Help!” letter the second thing Marjorie instructs you to do is access the root cellar. She provides a set of instructions that should be useful.
2. She tells you to “match” things up which points toward the match puzzle.
3. She also tells you that Jack might be able to help (he has additional instructions on how to work this particular puzzle).
4. Use the instructions that Marjorie and Jack provide to determine a numerical combination for the lock that will allow you to access the root cellar.
5. Remember that opposing directions cancel each other out so you can eliminate those from consideration.

Burger Card

1. To play and see if you are an instant winner enter the last 4 digits of the transaction number from the receipt to unlock the file.
2. In a note that she left, Marjorie says, “I recommend a burger and a good book when taking the red eye.”
3. Use the red lens from the 3D glasses to view the hidden numbers in the burger unlock. **Note: Do not wear the glasses. Hold the red lens over the image like a magnifying glass.
4. These numbers provide the correct order for the list of books she provided on the “More Thoughts From Behind the Wall by Marj” sheet.
5. List the books in the correct order.
6. Read the first letter of each book title.

Accessing The Little Library

1. The little library has a placard hanging underneath that says “What is here?”
2. The question is one that you answer from the previous puzzle involving the burger instant win card, the burger receipt, the 3d glasses, and the list of book titles.
3. Take the answer from the previous puzzle solution and use to unlock.
4. This is a two word answer (no caps, no spaces)

Star Door

1. Jack mentions a door with a chain fastened in a star pattern with a strange lock at the end of the tunnel beneath the wishing well.
2. You have another strange diagram with a riddle at the bottom that begins with “Make a wish...”
3. The word ‘wish’ is the key to link these two.
4. The riddle tells you that you are looking for a name (“name the one”)
5. It also says “Use most once, use one twice.”
6. Notice that two of the Roman numerals are circled once but one is circled twice.
7. Match up the Roman numerals that are circled with the number that corresponds to them on the lock that is pictured on the back of the Star Door card.
8. Use the letter that matches up with that particular number.
9. Remember that one of those numbers is used twice which means the letter is used twice as well.
10. You should end up with a 4 letter name.

Maze

1. When you unlock the Star Door there is a strange circular diagram on the floor with bull symbols scattered throughout.
2. You also have a maze that reads Family First at the top.
3. Find the letters in the maze that correspond to the bull symbols.
4. The bold lines from the Star Door unlock match up to the breaks in the maze.
5. You should obtain a word.
6. Use the word that you obtain to unlock the flash drive with the maze symbol on it.

Flash Drive

1. Notice the maze symbol on the flash drive.
2. The password gained by solving the maze/sigil from behind the Star Door puzzle is the unlock for this.

Newspaper Clipping From Flash Drive

1. When you unlock the flash drive you will be given a newspaper clipping with several words that have letters underlined in red.
2. You should have a card in your box with an audio recording that is labeled 'Play Me.'
3. In her recording, Marjorie Garcia mentions all of the words or phrases from the newspaper clipping.
4. Use the order that she mentions each of them to provide the correct order for the underlined letters.
5. You should end up with a word from this.
6. She also mentions at the end of her recording that "where there's smoke, there's fire."
7. This means to use the word that you obtain to unlock the fireplace.

Accessing the Fireplace

1. Use the word that you obtain from the previous puzzle with the newspaper clipping and voice recording to unlock this.
2. Take note of those houses that are marked with a red x and note which suspects those correspond to.
3. Marjorie has denoted that these are members of the cult.

Accessing the Shed

1. When accessing the little library, you should have gotten a moon chart that featured values for each moon phase.
2. You should also have a strange sheet with these same moon symbols.
3. Notice that the shed is locked with a rotary dial lock.
4. Jack provides some insight on how these locks work and even tells you the order.
5. Use the numbers that correspond to the moon phases marked L, R, and L.
6. Enter them in the correct order to access the shed.
7. Take note of those houses that are marked with a red x and note which suspects those correspond to.
8. Marjorie has denoted that these are members of the cult.

Unlocking the Box Beneath the Oak Tree

1. In the unlock to the root cellar, Marjorie leaves a strange message behind that begins, "Oh, and there's one more thing,"
2. You should have a document in your box with various images that match up to the things that Marjorie mentions (key, all-seeing eye, etc)
3. You also have a sheet of numbers that, when placed, over the sheet of images should correspond perfectly to the images.
4. Identify each image from Marjorie's message and find the corresponding number in the order that she mentions them.
5. Use this to unlock the box beneath the tree.
6. Take note of those houses that are marked with a red x and note which suspects those correspond to.

Welcome to Fairmont Estates

1. Jack mentions helping Marjorie Garcia break into the property manager's office and provides details on how to access that.
2. By now, you should have unlocked the box beneath the oak tree, the shed, and the fireplace.
3. Each of those unlocks feature two numbers in the upper right corner.
4. Consult Jack's notes to see which one to use (upper or lower)
5. Use the numbers in order to unlock the office.
6. This should be a six-digit number

Grid Map

1. When you unlock the property manager's office you are given a grid with a note from Marjorie.
2. She instructs you to determine the plots that no one owns.
3. Consult the Fairmont Estates Lot Ownership document.
4. Determine which plots on the map aren't owned and list them in order.
5. It may be helpful to draw off a recreation of the grid map and mark the plots that are owned.
6. There will be four plots left that have no owner.
7. These are the plots where the four missing girls are buried.
8. Use the plots in alphabetical order to unlock the "Where are the Missing Girls?" card.

Where Are The Missing Girls?

1. The answer to this puzzle comes from the information you've gained from the grid map/lot ownership puzzle.
2. You are looking for four plot coordinates in alphabetical order.

Box Solution

1. After unlocking the “Where are the missing girls?” card you should have noticed a specific word in all caps. This is the word used to describe the killer.
2. You also have been told that the killer isn’t a member of the cult you’ve been tracking.
3. At this point, you should have determined all of the members of the cult and are left with one who is not.
4. Use the first name of the killer and the word from the unlock to solve the box.
