# Clarissa's Love Letter

1. See if there is one particular word that stands out and examine the quote for a hint about the kind of puzzle you are dealing with.
2. Read Professor Ferguson's Consultant's Notes and see if you can find the key he is talking about. Once you have it, follow the directions he gives in order to solve the puzzle.
3. Your alphabet should look like this: shockabdefgijlmnpqrtuvwxyz. Using this, S=A, H=B, O=C, etc
4. The message should start with "Wolfie, what we..."

# Session 11:

1. Examine the symbol in the lower right corner of the page. Have you seen it anywhere else?
2. Take a look at the pill bottle and see if those letters mean anything.
3. This is an example of a ROT-13 Cipher. ABCNOP: A=N, B=O, C=P, etc
4. Write out the alphabet in two rows and match up the letters top to bottom and visa versa

A B C D E F G H I J K L M  
N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

5. The message starts with "Gavin has..."

# Session 10 (in booklet):

1. The puzzle seems to be a list of coordinates. Is there anything in the box that looks like a grid?
2. Examine the Pieces of Silver document.
3. Find each coordinate and write down the corresponding letter.
4. Find each of the values mentioned in the coded message (you gather this information from three separate documents) then follow the directions. They give you something really important.

# Noose Puzzle:

1. Is there anything in the box containing the names (and symbols) of elements?
2. Find each element on the Periodic Table from the booklet and write down the abbreviation for the element. Read them in order.
3. The message you get should start with "Attention..."

# Session 8 Puzzle:

1. Looks like Morse code.
2. Check the Detective's Notes.
3. The message should start with "Matthew..."
4. If you were to look up this verse in the Bible, you should notice some very familiar names mentioned.

# Password Needed to Unlock Mary Johns' Badge:

1. Examine the puzzle at the bottom of the detective's notes on Mary Johns. The answer is contained there.
2. The words are backwards.
3. The message should start with "I need to see..."
4. The message has the information needed to unlock Mary's badge.

# Computer Password:

1. Solve the puzzles for Sessions 8, 10, and 11 first. They will help you unlock the encoded file mentioned in Detective Wallace Hammett's report (the file Ricardo Wilkes talks about).
2. Put the three words together to form a phrase and use it as the password for the file. Don't use spaces.
3. Fill in all of the missing parts of your timeline.



# Medical Bracelet Puzzle:

1. Consult the chat transcript
2. Visit the link provided in the document.
3. Find the letter that is represented by each sequence of 1's and 0's and see what the message says.

# Mary Johns' Work Badge:

1. Scan the badge and use the information she provided in her coded message.
2. The heading at the top of the report tells you it is written in 24-hour/military time.
3. Most time clock systems use this format. If the time is 12:00 a.m.-11:59 a.m. the time is written as it would normally appear. If the time is 12:00 p.m. through 11:59 p.m. the time is expressed by adding 12 to the time. For example: 2:40 p.m. is written as 14:40 p.m.
4. This info should eliminate a suspect.

# Dr. Blackthorn's Work Badge:

1. This QR code is not locked. Scan to hear the voice memo.

# Useful Info:

1. Dr. Blackthorn mentions Finch's session time is changing. This lets Finch make it to the dress rehearsal.
2. The Judas Iscariot fact sheet has one really pertinent piece of information that ties in to the Thirty Pieces of Silver puzzle. Here is where you learn the meaning of that strange word you decoded.

# Eliminating Suspects

1. Pay close attention to the times for Mary when she clocked in and out.
2. The transcript conversation and Facebook note should help you eliminate a suspect.
3. Once you have the dress rehearsal info you should be able to eliminate 7 suspects.
