

Catch Me If You Can

*One Puzzle Per Page

Using the Items in the Pouch:

1. The items in the pouch will be used to unlock the circus, the bar, the tattoo parlor, and the arcade.

Unlocking the Circus

1. Blow up the balloon so you can read the words on both sides.
2. “Under the big top you’ll find one...”
3. Count what you have on both sides and make an easy association to come up with a word that would make sense in The Collector’s twisted game.
4. Use it to unlock the circus.
5. Take note of the symbol that you find and its meaning.

Unlocking the Bar

1. Examine the bottle opener in the pouch.
2. Use the arrows to determine which way to move along the alphabet.
3. Shift each letter in the correct direction.
4. Use the word you obtain to unlock the bar.
5. Take note of the symbol you find there and what it means.

Unlocking the Arcade

1. Pay special attention to the name of the arcade and the slogan.
2. Also take note of the words with stars above them.
3. Examine the arcade token and note that stars and an eagle's head are both featured on one side.
4. The slogan refers, in part, to the direction the eagle's head is facing.
5. Move in that direction from each of the stars and use the word you obtain to unlock the arcade.
6. Take note of the symbol you find and what it means.

Unlocking the Tattoo Parlor

1. Examine the sticker you have in your pouch.
2. Notice the graffiti message on the side of the tattoo parlor wall.
3. Do what the graffiti message says literally with regard to the letters on the sticker.
4. Take the remaining letters and use them to form a word that would be significant to The Collector.
5. Use this to unlock the tattoo parlor.
6. Take note of the symbol you find there and its value.

Cell Phone

1. The beginning brief gives you two places to start: the business card or the pouch of items.
2. If you start with the business card, it mentions giving The Collector a call and says maybe you'll Get Lucky (there is a card with this at the top).
3. Notice that the grid on the lottery ticket and the grid of apps on the phone correspond.
4. Use the numbers from the lottery ticket to give you the correct order for the apps.
5. *Note: Pay special attention to the last sentence on the business card. It is important.
6. **Note 2: Also pay special attention to the person who owns this phone (phone background). This information will be needed to move forward.

Library Unlock

1. The messages you get from the cell phone provide specific information on how to gain access to the library.
2. The map of Valley Falls University and the ID card belonging to the owner of the phone will be needed for this.
3. Make sure to keep up with every location on the map you find.

Bulfinch's Mythology

1. When you unlock the library, you obtain this book and find a message taped to the back.
2. The Collector instructs you to “use the name of the building you end up with to talk to my puzzled lady friend.”
3. You should have a sheet in your box that features a series of puzzle pieces that says “I’m puzzled.”
4. Count the number of each puzzle piece shape on the ‘I’m puzzled’ sheet and use that to complete the equation on the taped note.
5. The number you end up with provides the location to location number two on the map and also provides the answer to unlock the card featuring a woman’s face made entirely of puzzle pieces.
6. Note: To get the correct answer, you may have to rotate or flip some of the pieces for an accurate count.

Maze

1. You should have a maze with a skull at the top.
2. Work this as you would a normal maze and obtain a fact that will be useful.
3. Once you've unlocked the puzzle piece woman, you will obtain a notepad with the same skull at the top as the one on the maze.
4. This puzzle will give you two different message (one from completing the maze and one by substituting the words from the notepad with the words in the maze that lie on the correct path)
5. Substitute the words from the notepad with the words on the correct path of the maze.
6. This will give you location number three and tell you how to unlock the self portrait.
7. Make sure to take note of these.

Self-Portrait (strange painting on easel)

1. Use the information gained from the maze puzzle along with the information from the correct ID badge to unlock this.

SD Card

1. When you unlock the self-portrait (see previous step) you will obtain a card for the Valley Falls Computer Science Program.
2. One side of the SD card corresponds to the left side of the Computer Science Program Card.
3. The other side of the SD card applies to the right side of the Computer Science Program Card.
4. Left Side-find that letter on the Computer Science Program Card that matches up to the numbers (in order going from 1-20). Example: 1=H, 2=A, etc)
5. Do this for all of the numbers and obtain a message about location 4.
6. Right Side-use the flip side of the SD card to determine the order of colors.
7. The first color mentioned is red.
8. Find all of the red letters and use them to form a word. (First word = Ali's)
9. Repeat this for the additional colors, going in the order they are mentioned.
10. You will find out something useful that will be used with the Movie poster

Horrors/Cinema Unlock

1. One of the messages gained from the SD card puzzles will provide the information needed to unlock this.
2. You will also need information off of one of the ID cards.
3. Once you've unlocked the file, you will see a message that is difficult to read.
4. There is a hint in the upper left hand corner of the Horrors/Cinema poster that will help with reading this.
5. If squinting doesn't help reading this, try tilting your device and reading this from the side.

Death in A Suit/Eye in the Sky

1. Once you find all 5 locations, you need to determine what to do with them. The directions on the back of this card should help.
2. Each step is numbered and written in a different font
3. Read each step in the correct order and use the location numbers you've found to determine how to gain access to the eye in the sky.
4. Use what you learn to unlock the card that says "The Eye in the Sky Sees All!"

Login for Valley Falls University

1. When you unlock the Eye in the Sky card, the security guard not only tells you The Collector's real name but also says that he left some information for you on one of the security systems. It involves using the year Rhonda was born and the hidden message on her picture.
2. You will need the Polaroid photo for this and Rhonda's ID card.
3. You should notice that in the Polaroid The Collector has left some of his symbols on the chair that Rhonda is sitting in.
4. Note: These symbols don't correspond with the same letters that The Collector used in part 1.
5. Locating the four victims will be required to learn the value for each symbol (see unlocking the circus, the bar, the arcade, and the tattoo parlor)
6. The security guard also mentions things running like clockwork. That's a hint on how to read what you unlock.

Unlocking the Gate/345

1. When you gain access to the Valley Falls University security system, you discover that The Collector has patched you in to the locations where all four victims have been found.
2. He has left you a message that is read by going in a clockwise direction.
3. The message provides the password to unlock the 345 location.

Handprints

1. When you unlock the 345 Eagle Street address, you obtain a fingerprint and a set of handprints.
2. Determine which fingerprint on the card matches the one on the unlock. Take note of the number of the fingerprint.
3. The handprints on the unlock provide the way to decode the numbers associated with that fingerprint.
4. Determine which fingers the fingerprint value matches up with on the card and translate that number using what you've unlocked.
5. The Collector also tells you to use Paulina's special number.
6. Use the translated number you find along with the number found hidden on Paulina's ID card.
7. Take note of the information found on The Collector's word badge.

Prometheus/Man Getting Attacked by Eagle

1. Once you unlock the handprint card and rescue Rhonda, she gives you a clue about how to decode the card featuring Prometheus.
2. Her clue involves moving backwards and forwards along the alphabet.
3. Once you have the answer to this, you will have part of the answer to the final solution.

Final Solution

1. The components for the final solution will be found on the Prometheus puzzle solution and the Handprints unlock.
2. Take note of the blanks on the final solution card. This tells you how many characters you will use.
